SUBJECT: Resolution No. 2780-14, Purchase of Axon Flex Cameras with Related Equipment and Cloud Based Data Storage

Introduction: This is a request for the City Council to authorize the purchase of eight (8) new body cameras for police personal, related equipment, and data storage and related licenses for three (3) years of data storage services for evidentiary and recall storage for an amount not to exceed \$24,000 from Federal confiscated funds.

Discussion: On March 15, 2010, the City Council adopted Resolution number 2142-10 authorizing the purchase of in-car cameras for police vehicles. Due to technological advances, the use of in-car cameras has migrated to cameras that the officers wear. This migration allows video recordings of what the officer views, not just the view from the vehicle. The newer technology will replace the in-car cameras as those vehicles are removed from service.

Resolution No. 2780-14 also includes funding for Evidence.com (cloud based storage of all recordings for evidentiary and recall purposes) and a three (3) year warranty service.

Budget Impact: Sufficient funds are available in the Fund Balance of the Federal Law Enforcement Trust (106) Fund. Exhibit 1 of Resolution No. 2780-13 reflects the budget amendment using Fund Balance for the acquisition of equipment and data storage.

Strategic Impact: Ensure a high level of readiness to manage public safety and recover from disasters.

Recommendation: It is recommended that City Council adopt Resolution No. 2780-14.

RESOLUTION NO. 2780-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BODY WORN CAMERAS, RELATED EQUIPMENT, AND THREE (3) YEARS OF DATA STORAGE SERVICES FOR EVIDENTIARY AND RECALL STORAGE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$24,000; APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the benefit of using of cameras is a useful tool to document officer and citizen contact during traffic stops and contacts; and,

WHEREAS, technological advances has migrated from in-car cameras to cameras to be worn by officers to continue citizen document contacts away from the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, an the amount not to exceed \$24,000 for this purchase will purchase eight (8) cameras, related equipment, as well as funding for cloud based storage of all recordings for evidentiary and recall purposes and licenses for three (3) years of service; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment is necessary in order to fund the purchase of the cameras and the warranty, using fund balance within the Federal Law Enforcement Funds; and

WHEREAS, The Police Chief has determined the funding is an eligible use of the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund monies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Authorization of Purchase. The City Council hereby authorizes the purchase of body worn cameras, related equipment, and three (3) years of data storage services for evidentiary and recall storage for an amount not to exceed \$24,000 from the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund.


SECTION 2. Adoption of Budget Amendment. The City Council hereby approves the Budget Amendment provided in Exhibit 1 and the use of fund balance.

SECTION 3. Conflicts. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
