- Landscape Incentive Criteria:**
- A.1) Complete Application and initial audit by the Water Conservation Coordinator for landscape and irrigation.
 - 2) HOA sign off.
 - 3) Florida Water Use landscape conversion of high water use irrigation zones (Turfgrass, \$0.50 per sq. ft. minimum 500 sq. ft., maximum 2,000 sq. ft.) Replace with high or medium drought tolerant turfgrass or landscapes.
- Alternative Well Criteria:**
- B.1) Reclaimed is not available within ten (10) years.
 - 2) Obtain a City of Oviedo Well Permit.
 - 3) Convert irrigation to Alternative Water (Private Well).
