Friendship Park has reopened after getting new Forever Lawn. Stop by and see how great it looks!





Our new **Rescue** was on display at the Florida Fire Chiefs conference in Daytona. The new Wheeled Coach Rescue

has the Black over Red color design. It was a hit with the vendors and guests!

Chief White staffed the **Safe Haven for Newborns** booth at the Florida Fire chiefs Association Fire Rescue East Conference in Daytona as a member of the statewide foundation. As of this week, 219 newborns have been saved throughout the state among fire stations and hospitals as places of safe haven for parents desiring to anonymously place their newborn into the program. PUBLIC WORKS:

Update on the SR426—Redbug Lake Rd/ Mitchell Hammock Rd turn lane construction. We've had a few complaints about the traffic light at the intersection of Mitchell Hammock/Redbug Lake Road and SR426. The slowness of the light at the intersection is due to the construction taking place. The County is aware of the situation and it will be remedied as construction progresses. The construction will have the greatest impact on those who use the intersection between 8pm and 6am. From now until February 9th there will be paving operations, removal and construction of concrete traffic separators and roadway lane closures. There will be a maintenance of traffic plan in place during the construction.
