The Outdoor Tornado Siren Warning System received general maintenance and service this week. Chief White and the siren system vendor performed the routine maintenance. The system remains operational and has never failed in alerting the community for a potential tornado severe weather event.



Annual fire hose safety testing was completed among all of the department's fire engines and spare hose. Over 7000 feet of fire hose was inspected and tested as part of the annual program assuring for less chance of failures during emergency fire scene operations.

HUMAN RESOURCES:

The 2014 **Safety Inspections** of City facilities commenced on Thursday, November 6th and continues through November 18th. Favorable comments from the inspectors cited vast improvements at the facilities. Most of the violations noted are regarding housekeeping in storage areas. Fire codes typically require storage to be kept at least 18 inches beneath sprinkler deflectors so that there are adequate spray patterns from the sprinklers to extinguish a fire. The Inspections found a few storage rooms that had possible trip hazards. On a plus side, Fire extinguishers were adequately placed throughout all the facilities.

Overall, the City facilities are in good shape but we are striving for great by always putting SAFETY FIRST!!
