

NOTES TO PARENTS


- **Sign-in / Sign-Out procedure;** parents are required to sign their children in and out each day of camp at the front desk.
- **Photo identification will be required of the designated pick up person. NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule.**
- **A \$5 per day fee will be charged for Early Drop Off and/or After Camp Care. This fee will be charged everyday for anyone authorized to drop off between 7:30 and 8:00 am or pick-up between 5:00 and 6:00pm.**
- **Late pick up policy is as follows: \$5 per child for 1-15 minutes late, an additional \$1 per min per child for 16-30 min's late.**
- **If your camper brings money or valuables to camp, they are responsible for it.**
- **Always remember on field trip days to have your child dressed with their camp shirt.**
- **If your child is sick, please do not bring them to camp, we cannot be at their disposal all day.**
- **Refund requests made within 48 hours of payment will be given full refund. After 48 hours of payment there will be a 25% administration fee that will be deducted from your total payment, which will not exceed \$50, or will be issued a full credit on your household account. Once a full household credit is issued to your account, this money will stay in your household until used. No refunds will be issued from your household account. All refund requests must be in writing.**
- **Once camp begins if you decide to change weeks, there will be a \$5 transfer fee for this service.**

Summer Camp Concession Account

Summer camp concession accounts are available at both facilities (Riverside Park & Gym/Aquatic Facility). For your convenience there are 5 different fees that you can purchase for your camper, those are \$10, \$20, \$30, \$40, & \$50. You can purchase these at the front desk of either facility. This concession account will be maintained at the concession stand at either location. Concession accounts are not transferrable from the Gymnasium/Aquatics Facility camps to Riverside Park camps.

THIS ACCOUNT WILL EXPIRE ON THE LAST DAY OF CAMP. THERE WILL NOT BE ANY REFUNDS OR CREDITS TO YOUR HOUSEHOLD IF NOT USED.

The concession stand has a variety of other snacks available for the campers which are, Honey Buns, Cinnamon Rolls, Candy (M&M's, Hershey bars, Snickers, etc.), different size fountain drinks (16 & 32 oz's) & Powerade. There will be other items on the menu depending on which camp you have your child(ren) signed up for.



SPORTS CAMPS

Volleyball Camp

GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration Dates:

Adventure Camp, Club Riverside and Sports Camps:

Registration for all Summer Camps will begin on **Monday, March 7th**. Registrations will be accepted up until the Thursday before each session, or until each session is full.

You can register at the Oviedo Gym & Aquatic Facility, Riverside Park, or online for all summer camp programs, using your WebTrac login information. If you do not have your login information, please inquire at the Front desk at either location for details. When you are doing online registration all fees are due at time of registration. If you are applying for a scholarship you need to register at either facility mentioned above, you cannot do on-line registration. **When you register for camp all payments are due on day of registration in full.** We will be giving out one t-shirt per camper for the entire summer. Your t-shirt and camp schedule may be picked up at the front desk on Monday mornings. If additional shirts are requested, they may be purchased for an additional \$5.

There will be a \$10 discount for every week paid prior to Monday, March 28, 2016. There is also a \$10 sibling discount **ONLY** if attending same weeks of camp at the same camp setting.

Refund/Transfer Policy

Refund requests made within 48 hours of payment will be given a full refund. Refund requests made after 48 hours of payment, and prior to the Friday before the registered session, will be charged a 25% administration fee, not to exceed \$50 per transaction, or will be issued a full credit on their household account. Once a full household credit is issued to your account, this money will stay in your household until used. No refunds will be issued from your household account. Once each session begins, there are no refunds or credits.

All changes or refunds **MUST** be in writing **BEFORE** change or refund can be issued.



CLUB RIVERSIDE

Club Riverside offers a variety of activities for children ages 6-13 (elementary and middle school) attending the camp. On a daily basis they will engage in various activities going outdoors and indoors. These activities are suited to the age of the children attending camp and can include anything from (outdoor) kickball, flag football, volleyball, tennis, capture the flag, and swimming, which is done on a daily basis, to (indoor) boardgames (Monopoly, Life, Operation, etc...) dodgeball, arts & crafts, and reading which is offered on a daily basis for 30 minutes.

During the week they will go on 2 field trips which could include but are not limited to Wet n' Wild, DeLeon Springs, Daytona Lagoon, Semoran Skateway, Boing Jump Center, etc...

The campers have a 30 minute lunch break, and also 2 snack times during their day at camp.

The counselor-camper ratio is 1-15. The summer at Club Riverside is one of memory and friendship making that will last a lifetime. Come and join us this summer and give your child a summer to remember.

For Non-Resident Membership information, inquire at the front desk at Riverside Park or at the Gymnasium & Aquatic Facility.

With a non-resident membership your savings would be as follows: Sign up for 3 weeks of camp and you save \$60 which recovers the \$50 membership cost for the family; if you sign up for all seven weeks this summer you end up saving \$140 and this is just for one child.

Summer Camp is for children ages 6-13.

Camp goes from June 6—July 29, 2015. There will be no camp on Monday, July 4, 2016, this is the official city holiday for Independence Day.
