
A RENOVATED PUBLIC SAFETY COMPLEX COULD BE USED FOR A MULTITUDE OF OPERATIONS:

CITY OF OVIEDO REFERENDUM ELECTION

Modern Police Station And Public Safety Complex Renovation Project; General Obligation Bonds For Facilities.

To construct a modern police station and renovate the current Public Safety Complex the City requires funding for the project. Shall the City issue bonds not exceeding \$11,400,000 bearing interest not exceeding maximum legal rates pledging the City's full faith and credit for 30 years from date of issuance, payable from ad valorem taxes levied on all City taxable property, without limitation as to the rate or amount, as provided in Ordinance No. 1640?

HALLOWEEN SAFETY

Halloween is one of the most anticipated nights of the year for kids, but Safe Kids' research* shows some scary statistics on Halloween safety.



Only **1/3 OF PARENTS** talk to their kids annually about Halloween, although 3/4 report having Halloween safety fears.

On average, **TWICE AS MANY CHILD PEDESTRIANS** are killed while walking on Halloween compared to other days of the year.

Only **18%** of parents use reflective tape on their children's Halloween costumes.

12% of children five years of age or younger are permitted to trick-or-treat alone.

Talk with your goblins about Halloween safety, and how simple precautions can make it a fun and safe night for kids of all ages. For additional safety tips, please visit SafeKids.org/Halloween

Children under 12 should trick-or-treat and **CROSS STREETS WITH AN ADULT**

ALWAYS WALK ON SIDEWALKS OR PATHS if there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the side as possible.

Cross the street at corners, **USING TRAFFIC SIGNALS** and crosswalks. Parents should remind children to watch for cars that are turning or backing up.

DRIVERS SHOULD SLOW DOWN and be especially alert in residential neighborhoods. Children are excited on Halloween and may move in unpredictable ways.

- * **Indoor Cycling** - Tuesday and Thursday, 6 - 7pm. Daily rates apply. Packages of 20 visits or an unlimited annual option are available for purchase.

Hear the **BEEP** where you **SLEEP**

Every Bedroom Needs a Working Smoke Alarm!

Half of home fire deaths happen between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m., when most people are asleep.



Install smoke alarms in every bedroom, outside each separate sleeping area, and on every level of the home, including the basement. Larger homes may need more alarms.

For the best protection, install interconnected smoke alarms in your home. When one sounds, they all sound.



Test alarms at least once a month by pushing the test button.




Some people, especially children and older adults, may need help to wake up. Make sure someone will wake them if the smoke alarm sounds.



Replace all smoke alarms when they are 10 years old or if they do not sound when tested.



When the smoke alarm sounds, get outside and stay outside. Go to your outside meeting place.



Call the fire department from a cellphone or a neighbor's phone. Stay outside until the fire department says it's safe to go back inside.
