Tips for Managing Hazardous Waste in an Environmentally Responsible Manner

- ❖ Before purchasing a product, read the label and ensure the product will do what you want.
- ❖ Look for non-hazardous/less toxic alternatives when selecting a product.
- ❖ Less is best! Only buy as much as you need.
- ❖ Completely use product up or give away unwanted leftover product to a neighbor or friend. For example, paint is not hazardous when dry.
- ❖ Dispose of unwanted product at the Seminole County Central Transfer Station.
