




All-In-One Recycling™

Improvements are here, but your service date will not change.

- All-In-One™ 96-gallon recycling cart, with automated pick-up, is replacing existing 18-gallon Dual-Stream bins. It will be more efficient and cost-effective.
- All-In-One Recycling™ allows residents to place recyclables into a single cart.
- All-In-One™ carts come with lids, like existing waste carts, and will prevent items from blowing around.
- The All-In-One™ cart takes up less floor space than multiple smaller bins. Residents can keep their old bins to enhance recycling collection within their home, or recycle them in the new cart.
- The All-In-One™ cart is easier for residents to place curbside compared to multiple smaller bins.
- All-In-One™ carts, if damaged, are easily repairable or replaceable by contacting Republic Services.
- All-In-One™ historically increases recycling participation, which is better for the environment and could help Oviedo to lower refuse hauling rates. Effective December 1, 2013, this enhanced recycling program saved City residents 41¢ per month.

accepted items

PAPER



newspaper, craft paper, shredded paper, phone books, paperback books, magazines

PLASTIC



#1-#7 plastics, detergent & cleaning containers, milk jugs, soda bottles, water bottles

CARDBOARD



paper towel cores, cereal boxes, cardboard boxes

ALUMINUM



beverage cans, backing tins, food cans

OTHER METAL



steel food containers

GLASS



clear glass, green glass, brown glass

non-accepted items

- aerosol cans
- aluminum foil
- batteries
- diapers
- light bulbs
- needles or syringes
- mirrors or ceramics
- paint
- sanitary products
- scrap metal
- stickers and address labels
- styrofoam and paper to-go containers
- tissue, paper towels or napkins

recycling tips

- Place the new recycling cart curbside along with your garbage cart on your regular service day.
- Rinse bottles, cans or food containers before placing them in the cart.
- Place items individually into the recycling cart, rather than in bags.
- Break cardboard boxes down to save room in the cart.
- No need to worry about leaving items on paper products, such as address labels, metal fasteners, paper clips, plastic tabs, rubber bands, spiral bindings, stamps or staples.
